Thirteen of some of the most famous artworks are showcased, with fascinating facts and information that will engage and interest students of all ages.

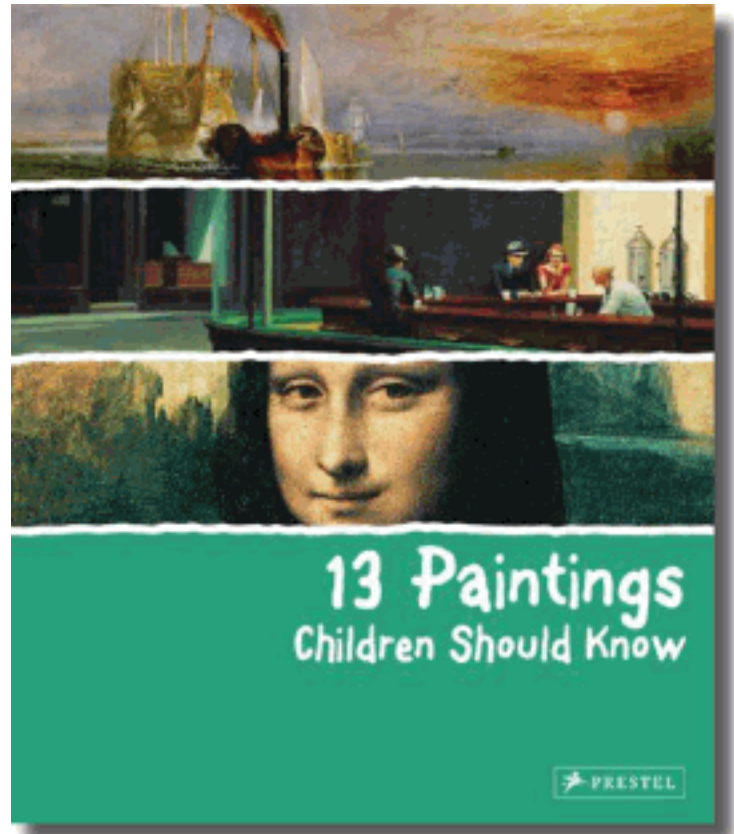
The images are high quality, bold reproductions, making this book really useful for classroom instructional purposes.
