

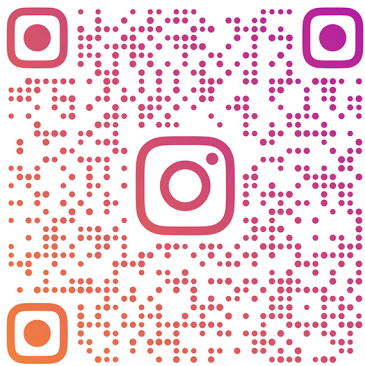
# Fragmented Portraits

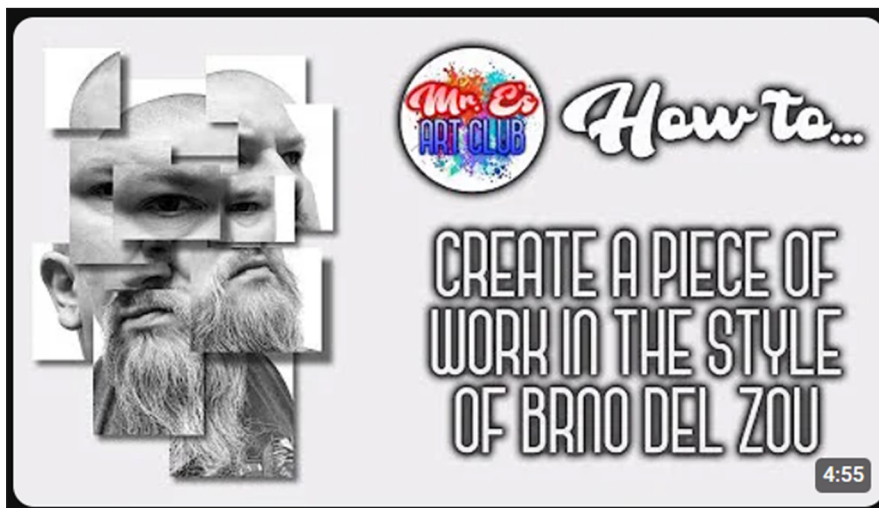

# Now it's your turn!

Find a partner or work individually and take a MINIMUM of 15-20 photos of either yourself, your partner OR an interesting object of your choice.

Take each photo from various angles and points of view, focusing on the face/most interesting view of your object only.

Your photos must have a plain background OR you will need to remove the background in photoshop. You also need to make sure you have a well-lit subject.

Start arranging and deciding on which facial features/sections of your chosen object you will use and duplicate – Those ready may start creating their final composition.



## **Your final composition:**

A minimum of 10 layered photographs with a shadow backdrop

Greyscale (black and white)

High contrast/brightness

Created in Adobe Photoshop or Photopea

Exported as a .PSD file OR .JPG and take and submit screenshots of your layers.
